The exhibitor also agrees that the MWEA and the Facility will not be responsible for any injury, loss or damage that may occur to the exhibitor, the exhibitor's employees or property or to any other person prior, during or subsequent to the period covered by the Exhibit Contract provided said injury, loss or damage is not caused by the willful negligence or wrongful act of an employee of the Facility and agrees to expressly release the MWEA and the Facility against any and all claims for such injury, loss or damage.

It is mutually agreed that it is the duty and responsibility of each exhibitor to install their exhibit before the opening of the exhibit and to dismantle it immediately after the close of the exhibit. All exhibits can be set up starting at 7:30 a.m. on Thursday, May 16th, 2019. Exhibit booths include: (1) covered and skirted table, (2) chairs, and 110-volt electrical service. Vendors will also be given an opportunity to speak during the scheduled vendor update, as well as opportunities throughout the program to meet and talk with attendees. Note: Please contact MWEA in advance if you have large equipment or oversized displays. All event emails that go out with exhibitors name/logo listed will link to the homepage of the company's website.
